

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**ORDINANCE NO. 2017 - O - 004**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SALE AND DISPOSAL OF  
SURPLUS VILLAGE PROPERTY – TWO (2) MOTOR VEHICLES  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, VILLAGE OF BURNHAM, COOK  
COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois has elected by referendum on March 11, 1980 to become a home rule unit, and accordingly, pursuant to the provisions of the *Constitution of the State of Illinois* of 1970, particularly Article VII Sec. 6 (a) thereof, the Village is a home rule unit; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the powers of a home rule unit set forth in Article VII, Section 6(a) of the *Constitution of the State of Illinois* of 1970, the Village may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license; to tax; and to incur debt; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has determined according to law that there exists certain personal property owned by the Village that is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and is hereby declared to be surplus property; and

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Village President (Mayor) and Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

**Section 1. THAT**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find that all the recitals contained in the preambles of this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference as if they were set forth verbatim in this section; and

**Section 2. THAT**, pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 (the "Code"), the President and the Board of Trustees find the following property to be no longer necessary or useful to the Village and is hereby declared surplus property:

- A. 2000 FORD CROWN VICTORIA FOUR-DOOR PASSENGER CAR  
V.I.N.: 2FAFP71W9YX156025
  
- B. 1996 DODGE RAM WAGON B3500 SPORT VAN  
V.I.N.: 2B5WB35ZXTK155387

**Section 3. THAT,** pursuant to the authority of the Code, the President and Board of Trustees hereby authorize and direct the Chief of Police or his designee to dispose of said surplus property in any manner he sees fit which may include junking said vehicles for scrap or the sale of the above property, with or without advertising to the highest bidder, as salvage property, or any other lawful means; and

**Section 4. THAT,** this Ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such Ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or, (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a manner not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois that to the extent that the terms of this Ordinance should be inconsistent with any no-preemptive state law, that this Ordinance should supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction; and

**Section 5. THAT,** if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance; and

**Section 6. THAT,** all Ordinances, Resolutions, Motions or Orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and


**Section 7. THAT,** this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication according to law; and

**Section 8. THAT,** this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by the authority of the Village President (Mayor) and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois.
